Graduation is an opportunity to recognize the efforts of our students as they accomplish milestones in the Suzuki literature. Teachers help their students prepare a polished performance and recording of their graduation piece. Care should be taken to follow SANC guidelines. Recordings are submitted by the teacher to SANC for evaluation. Graduates receive a diploma, award pin, and written evaluation, which are distributed by the private teacher after graduation day.

Students who submit recordings are expected to perform together at the Celebration Concert.
